# Directions to the Site: From the North:

Take Intersate 95S toward New Hampshire to exit #3B-Greenland/Portsmouth. Turn left on Greenland Rd (RT-33). Turn left on Portsmouth Ave (RT-151).

Turn left to follow Rt-151, trial site is on the right - LOOK FOR THE PINK NEAT BANNER.

### From the South:

Take Interstate 95N toward New Hampshire to exit #2-Exeter/Hampton onto Rt-101 West toward Manchester/Concord/Exeter(toll road). Take exit #12-Exeter/North Hampton onto Rt-111 toward North Hampton. Bear left on Post Rd (Rt-151). Trial site is on the left-LOOK FOR PINK NEAT BANNER. To avoid toll road take I95N to exit #1-Seabrook/Kingston onto Rt-107 toward Seabrook (US-1). Turn left on Lafayette Rd (US-1). Turn left on Post Rd (RT-151).

#### From the West:

Take Rt-101 East to exit #11-Stratham(Rt-33)/Exeter(Rt-88) toward Stratham(Rt-33)/Portsmouth. turn left at end of ramp on Portsmouth Ave (Rt-108). This is a strange intersection. Turn right on Stratham Heights Rd. Turn right on Bunker Hill Ave. Continue on Lovering Rd. Turn left on Post Rd (Rt-151). Trial site is on the left - LOOK FOR PINK NEAT BANNER.

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#### **Entries & Acceptance**

### **Express & Overnight Entries**

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

### General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com.

### No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

### Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

#### **NSF Check/Credit Card**

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

### **Refund Policy**

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

#### **NEAT Refund Policy**

Please note: Overpayments of entry fees are not refundable. Please check your math!

A dog or handler who suffers an injury and/or illness, or bitches that come into season after the closing date may be eligible for a refund of up to 50% of the total entry fee paid for that dog. Requests for said refunds must be received in writing by the Test Secretary by Monday, May 7 at Noon and must be accompanied by a dated letter from the veterinarian or doctor on the veterinarian's or doctor's letterhead with a brief description explaining the reason the dog, or the handler, cannot compete.

#### Next-Day Move-Ups Allowed At This Event

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level THE NEXT DAY at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days ARE allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary BEFORE she leaves the site the day on which you earn your title.

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### **General Entry Conditions**

#### Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

### **Policy on Fault Limits**

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

#### **Prohibitions on Aids & Devices**

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

#### Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

#### **Read your Confirmations**

<u>Please READ your preconfirmations and your final confirmations.</u> Verify that all information relating to you and your dog is correct. Please see the secretary's web site, <u>www.trialsecretary.com</u>. Lots of information about the trial will be posted there: List of Competitors; Competitor Catalog; Volunteer Schedules and any potential updates to the trial. Any changes made after the move-up date will incur a \$5 charge, per change, payable in cash to the Trial Secretary at the trial.

### **Mixed-Height Pairs Entry Allowed**

Dogs entered as partners in pairs relay at this event may be combined without regard to jump height, i.e. a mini dog may be entered as a partner with an open dog. Any pair consisting of at least one open dog must qualify in accordance with the QCT set forth by the judge of record for Open Pairs AND will be considered an open pair for placement purposes.

#### **Veterans Classes**

Gamblers, Jumpers, Snooker, Standard classes will be offered for Veterans.

### **Prizes & Awards**

### **Tilting Class & Tournament Awards**

#### TITLING CLASSES:

Starters/PI Standard: Ribbons for 1st through 6th place in each jump height.

Advanced/PII - Masters/PIII/Veterans Standard & ALL Levels of non-standard: Ribbons for 1st through 4th place in each jump height and to mini/open for Pairs Relay. A maroon qualfying ribbon will be awarded for those achieving a qualifying score in any regular class being held for certification purposes.

#### TOURNAMENTS:

Grand Prix/Performance Grand Prix Qualifiers: 1st through 3rd place ribbons will be awarded in each jump height. All qualifiers receive maroon and white qualifying ribbons. The first place qualifier in each height class in both tournaments will receive a 'bye' voucher for a Regional.

Steeplechase/Performance Speed Jumping: Qualifying ribbons will be awarded after the first round to all dogs earning a qualifying score. 1st through 3rd place ribbons and monetary awards will be awarded after Round 2 is complete.

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### Check-in & Measuring

### **Dog Measurements & Certification**

All dogs not jumping 26" in the Championship Program or 22" in the Performance Program must be measured unless they have a permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration card or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). When not enrolling electronically, please send a copy of one the following items to facilitate the check-in process:

- photocopy of permanent dog registration card,
- printout of the dog-information page from your USDAA® competitor web account, or
- copy of your check-in letter from USDAA indicating your temporary card has been accepted by the USDAA office and your permanent registration card is in process.

#### Self Check-in

Self Check In will be available for competitors who have submitted a copy of their dog's "Plastic Permanent Height Card". See above for eligibility.

### A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In - May Run FEO

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may opt to run the dog in the lower jump height class "For Exhibition Only", and no awards or qualifying scores may be earned. The competitor may not change their entry from one program to another (e.g., from Championship to Performance).
